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ABSTRACT

Designed to provide a descriptive picture of the tocchers of Marikina District III, this study determined the relationship between the perforance ratings and set 2 lected variables such as educational qualification, tepching experience and in-service training activities.

The study tested the following hypotheses:

- There is no significant relationship between educational qualification and performance rating.
- There is no significant relationship between the mumber of years of experience and performance rating.
- There is no significant relationship between the number of hours of in-service training attended and performance rating.

Using the chi-square test of relationship at the .05 level of significance, the study yielded the following con-

- There is highly significant relationship between educational qualification and performance rating.
- There appears a significant relationship between length of tenching experience and performance rating.
- There is no significant relationship between the number of hours of in-service training activities and performance rating.
